Madhok Foundation is a Non Profit NGO registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860 on 9th November 1999. On the social front it works towards the upliftment, empowerment and rehabilitation of the deprived, the destitute, the disadvantaged and the disabled section of the society both in Delhi and in other states. On the academic front the foundation undertakes research/advocacy, capacity building, counseling, health, education & environment.

Location

Madhok Foundation is a registered NGO (1999) with its registered office located in 8408-Sector C-8 Vasant Kunj New Delhi India and its branch office in Jaipur, Rajasthan. In Delhi the office functions from MCD Community Center-Sunlight Colony -1,New Delhi 14 .Shankar Mandir Ashram New Delhi ,Savada Ghewra Delhi & Zakir Nagar New Delhi . The branch office from Jaipur functions from 3/93 SFS Aggrawal Farm Manasarover Jaipur Rajasthan.

Activities of Madhok Foundation.;-

Homes for the Homeless ;--

Madhok Foundation has been building a one room tenement for the slum dwelling and homeless people. More than 60 homes have been built so far with solar lights installed on each home to make up for the shortage of electricity in the colony. These homes are being built in Savada Ghewra, a suburb located about 35 km outside of the main city of Delhi. The homes are being built in collaboration with "Habitat For Humanity, HDFC Ltd and HT Pareekh Foundation".

CHILD WELFARE ACTIVITIES

Madhok foundation offers reading facilities to young children through a Children's Library supported by the Rotary Club of Delhi .Youth and adolescents are also engaged in activities like planting trees, organizing environment awareness campaigns and cleanliness drives .Some of the street children sponsored by Madhok Foundation are studying in SOS Village - St. Joseph's school Sanchipuram, Faridabad and Tamanna school



in Nazafgarh.





SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND VOCATIONAL COURSES'--

COMPUTER COURSE

This course known as TESCOS (Technical Education Community Outreach Scheme) is imparted to the dropouts/school going children and youths belonging to the socio-economically weaker section of the society. This course is financially supported by the department of Training and Technical Education Govt. of NCT of Delhi. It is a 3 months course covering 120 hours. In a year near about 500 beneficiaries are trained in

BEAUTY CULTURE

This is one of the most popular course among the girls and women. With the financial and technical support from JSS (Jan Shikshan sanstan) Ministry of HRD Govt. of India this course is being run at Madhok Foundation in Sunlight Colony. After the training they are in a position to start their own parlor or to get employment in the same field.





TAILORING COURSE

This financial year we have trained more than 100 girls and women in cutting and tailoring trade. It is a six months course. At the end of the training the trainees are issued course certificates.. After completing the training many of them work from home and supplement the family income. Others take up jobs with various agencies Export Houses.





SENIOR CITIZEN RECREATIONAL CENTRE

Madhok Foundation has been running a senior citizen recreational Centre for the last 4 years with the help of directorate of social welfare, Govt of Delhi. The centre is functioning from Shankar Mandir Harinagar Asharam. Most of the members are females. Present strength of the Centre is 58. (39 female and 9 males).





A number of facilities are provided to the members such as, Kirthans on every Fridays, Counseling, outings, Medical Checkups, legal assistance, Festival celebrations and supplementary nutrition. In the winter season blankets are given to the senior citizen. This recreational Centre provide the elderly a forum to discuss their personal problems and difficulties and get proper guidance from our counselors. For health & comfortable

ageing Yoga classes are organized on every Friday for 2 hours by Mr. Ashok Kumar Jha a trained Yoga teacher.



MAHILA PANCHAYAT

It is an initiative taken up by the Delhi Commission for women[DCW] for legal empowerment of women and for distress redress at the community level. A large group of local women identified by Madhok Foundation form a panchayat[Congregation] in their area, take up local disputes, counsel the warring parties and assist in reducing violence in their locality. There are two regular staff to deal these issues, one Coordinator and the other a Community mobilizer. They are selected from the community and trained in handling warring parties, taught different laws pertaining to women and guided in the process of counseling distresses women.



Swatch Bharat-The Cleanliness Drive

All the women with youth s organized a cleanliness drive in the community area to generate awareness regarding Swatch [Clean } Bharat[India]

Mr Anil Kumar CEO of Gram Vikas Evam Samajik Badalav Kendr Najafgarh was the chief guest for the cleanness drive organized by the Mahila Panchayat. He highlighted the role of women in inculcating good habits in children. The members cleaned the community centre area as an action component of this program.
